All volleyball matches are played on Mondays from 5:45-7pm at Park de la Cruz (3901 Landis Street, San Diego 92105). Teams will stretch and warm-up at 5:30pm. The first match will start at 5:45pm. For the Intermediate (I) Division, each match consists of 2 games to 15 points (must win by 2 points). For the Advanced (A) Division, each match consists of 1 game to 25 points (must win by 2 points). The second match starts right after the first match is completed. The third match starts right after the second match is completed.

The 1st team listed wears yellow uniforms. The 2nd team listed wears green uniforms.

The 4-team Intermediate (I) Division teams plays a double round robin. The 3-team Advanced (A) Division teams play each other every week. The tie-breaker rules are: 1) Head-to-head match record among tied teams, 2) Head-to-Head game record among tied teams, and 3) Head-to-Head point differential among tied teams. On Nov 18<sup>th</sup> ribbons will be awarded after the completion of the matches. The S4EA Volleyball Tournament is scheduled for Saturday, November 23 from 9am-4pm at the Balboa Park Activity Center, which will conclude the fall volleyball season.

For the 3 weeks after volleyball ends, S4EA is offering Pickleball from 5:30-7pm at Park de la Cruz on Nov 25, Dec 2 & Dec 9. Pickleball has become very popular recently, so S4EA is going to offer pickleball again. Pickleball is a cross between tennis, badminton & ping pong.

In addition to registering with S4EA, athletes must also register with the City of San Diego on-line with <u>SDRecConnect.com</u> using code <u>118020</u> or register at the first practice with SDP&R-TRS.
